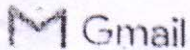

Greetings from Safe Kids Foundation!

This email is with regards to Training on Road Safety for your students.

Safe Kids Foundation is a nonprofit organisation dedicated to the prevention of unintentional childhood injuries which take place on roads (road accidents, falls, drowning, etc.) which is a leading cause of death and disability among children globally.

Safe Kids foundation conducts educational/awareness sessions on various aspects of road safety such as, pedestrian safety, passenger safety, defensive driving, motorbike safety, use of helmet, drunken drive, use of seat belts etc. and several awareness activities are conducted to educate people on road safety

In case of fatal accidents and road injuries the bystanders plays an important role in saving the life of an accident victim and thus training in trauma care. According to the study by the Indian Journal of Surgery in 2006, 80 percent of road accident victims in India do not receive any emergency medical care within the golden hour. It provides awareness on trauma care and provides skills about basic life support techniques and other pre-hospital care to layperson and sensitizes, encourages and empowers youth and other adults/ bystanders to come forward and give necessary pre-hospital care to the accident victims during golden hour. .

We wish to conduct one such Training workshop on road safety with your (first and second year) students to educate and empower more youth groups. The duration of the training would be of 1 hour and 30 minutes and is free of cost.

We encourage students to take part in the competition, which will be organised by Traffic Tech Park, for the which the students can prepare a poem, essay, drawing, poster, etc. on road safety and submit it to us on the day of the workshop, the artwork of students will be collected on the day of the workshop by Traffic Infra Tech representative. 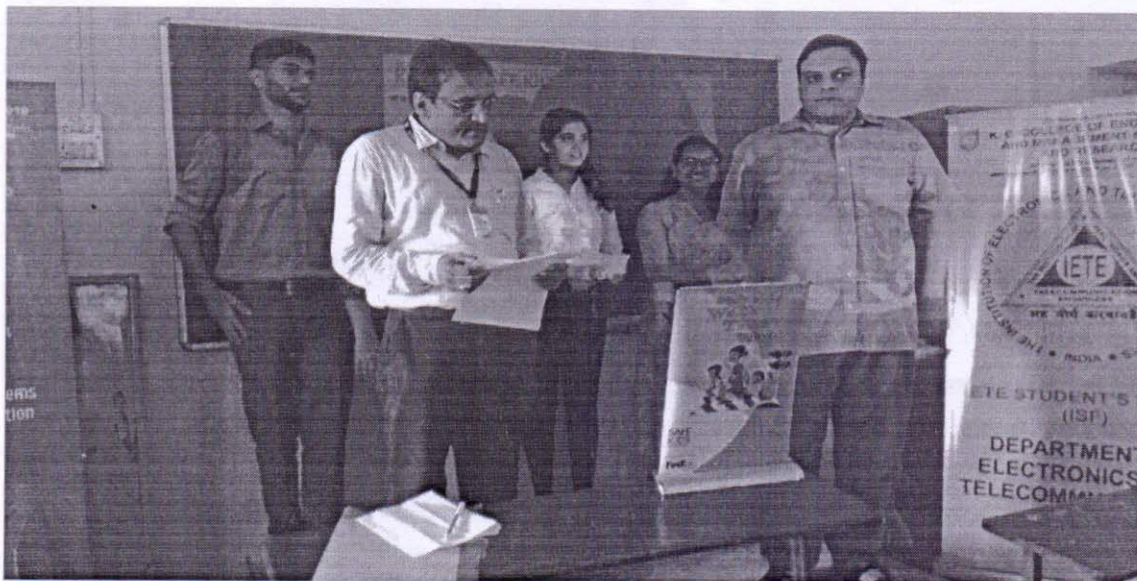

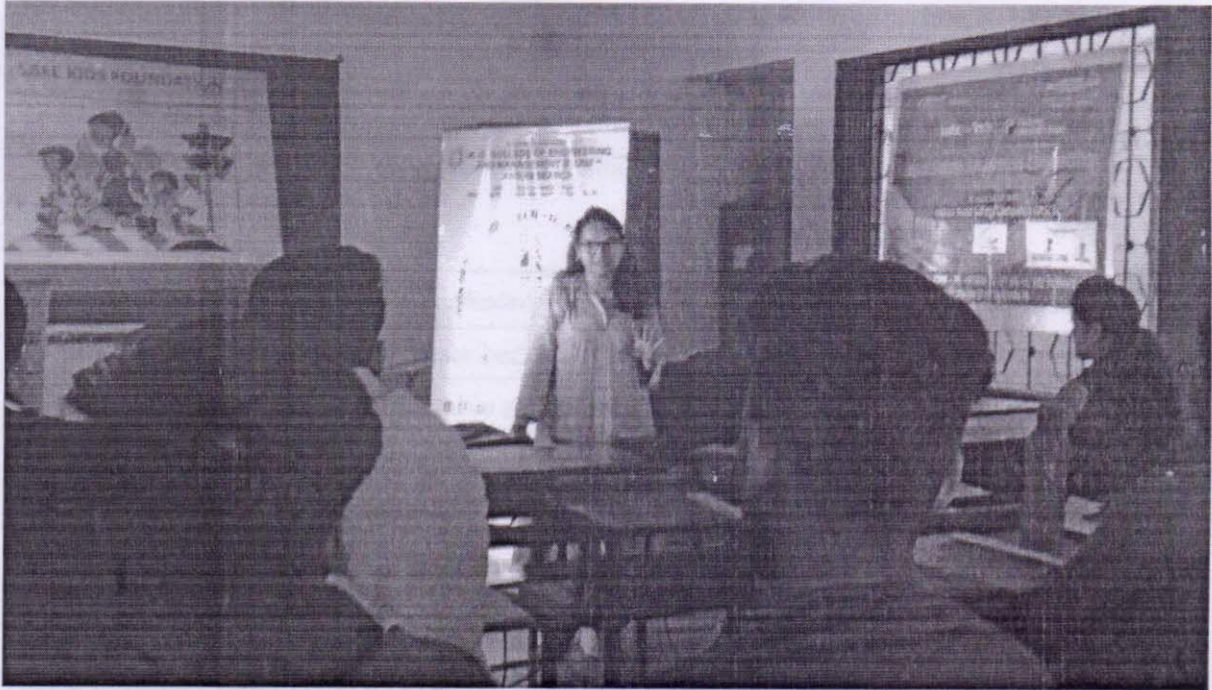

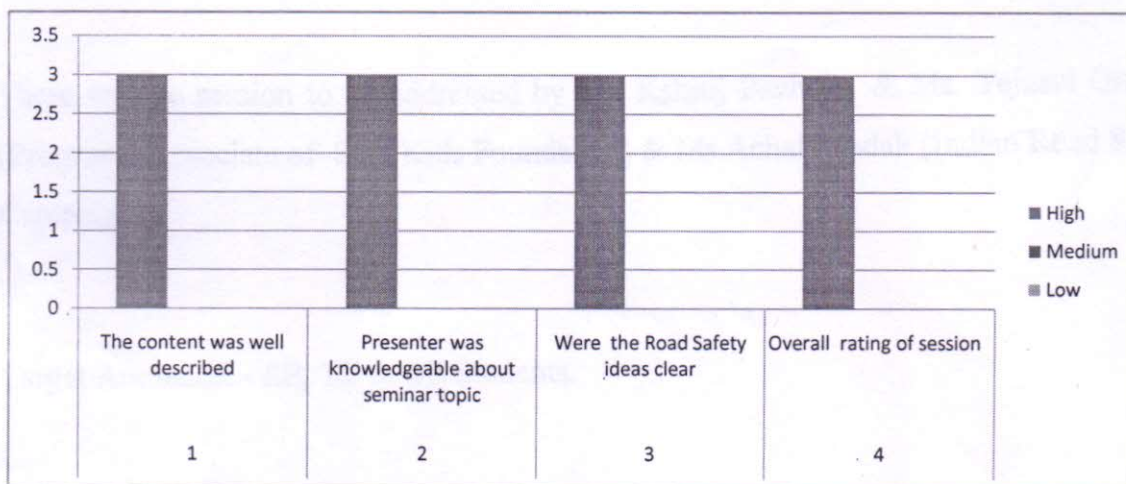
